第1天 出境 ➤ 中转城市 机上用餐

集合于国际机场，乘搭国际航班途经中转城市飞往瑞士-苏黎世。

第2天 中转城市 ➤ 苏黎世 机上用餐/晚

苏黎世: 瑞士第一大城市，全欧洲最富裕的城市，又被称为“欧洲亿万富翁都市”。  
**苏黎世市区游:** 圣母教堂的夏加尔窗户，**利马得河畔街**和**市政厅**。  
**班霍夫大道:** 世界上最富有的街道。始于公元前15年罗马统治时期，罗马人在苏黎世湖畔建城，它便开始发展成为兴旺的商贸中心。  
**苏黎世 - A-Ja Resort Zurich 或同级**

第3天 苏黎世 55km 卢塞恩 55km 苏黎世 早午晚

**铁力士山(含旋转缆车):** 铁力士山属于阿尔卑斯山脉，其海拔3020米，是瑞士中部最高峰，拥有中部唯一的冰川。在此可乘坐360度旋转缆车到达铁力士山的冰川公园，在攀升的过程中可以全方位饱览四周的美景。  
**卢塞恩:** 瑞士中部卢塞恩州的首府。  
**卡贝尔桥:** 这条廊桥是欧洲现存最古老的木桥，卢塞恩的地标，也是瑞士的著名景点之一。  
**狮子纪念碑:** 誉为“世界上最悲壮和最感人的雕像”，是纪念当年在法国革命牺牲的瑞士士兵。  
**卢塞恩湖:** 瑞士境内第五大湖泊，夹在阿尔卑斯山的群峰之间。  
**宝齐莱表店:** 瑞士一家奢华的独立制表品牌，隶属宝嘉尔集团。  
**苏黎世 - A-Ja Resort Zurich 或同级**

第4天 苏黎世 410km 法兰克福 早午晚

**莱茵大瀑布:** 游览最壮观的瑞士和德国交接大瀑布。  
**法兰克福:** 德国中西部的黑森州的第一大城市，也是德国的第五大城市。  
**蒂蒂湖:** 黑森林地区最大的天然湖，德语中的意思是“少女之湖”。  
**布谷鸟钟店:** 布谷鸟钟是德国西南部黑森林地区的特产，每到半点和整点，钟上方的小木门就会自动打开，并且出现一个会报时的布谷鸟，发出悦耳的“咕咕”的叫声。因此，也称作咕咕钟。  
**免税精品店:** 这里汇集了众多国际名品，如黑森林布谷鸟钟、品牌厨具、时尚箱包、首饰配件等等。  
**法兰克福 - TRYP by Wyndham Frankfurt 或同级**

第5天 法兰克福 190km 科隆 268km 阿姆斯特丹 早午晚

**科隆:** 德国第四大城市。  
**科隆大教堂:** 称为“黑教堂”的，1996年被指定为世界文化遗产；它是科隆的主要建筑标志。  
**大圣玛尔定教堂:** 一座罗马天主教教堂，以其宏伟壮观的四分基塔顶和三叶草状的地面形状而闻名。  
**科隆市政厅:** 这是德国最古老的市政厅，已有900余年历史。  
**阿姆斯特丹:** 风车之国，素有北方威尼斯之称，以运河为出名。  
**阿姆斯特丹 - The niu Fender 或同级**

第6天 阿姆斯特丹 早午晚

**桑斯安斯风车村:** 这里可以观看很多风车，荷兰人如何用风车解决几百年的水患。  
**奶酪农场和木鞋工厂:** 了解荷兰木鞋来历和新鲜奶酪的制作过程。  
**沃伦丹:** 一个著名老渔村，村里的特点可以看到渔船和穿着传统服装的居民，让你体验道地的传统文化。  
**郁金香季节(3月22日至5月13日)，**将以库肯霍夫花园代替沃伦丹。

**钻石切割工厂:** 了解荷兰的专业切割技术，把钻石打磨成各种装饰。  
**阿姆斯特丹运河(含船票):** 沿途可欣赏阿姆斯特丹的美景如：玛格丽桥、科学博物馆、港口、火车站等。

**大坝广场:** 曾是阿姆斯特丹唯一的市中心广场。第一个水坝就建在这里，因此得名。

**皇家宫殿:** 在17世纪荷兰黄金时代兴建时是阿姆斯特丹的市政厅，位于大坝对面。

**国家纪念碑:** 位于广场中心，为了纪念二战停战的时期。

**德瓦伦:** 在阿姆斯特丹被称为红灯区。

**阿姆斯特丹 - The niu Fender 或同级**

第7天 阿姆斯特丹 209km 布鲁塞尔 307km 巴黎 早午晚

**布鲁塞尔:** 比利时最大的城市和首都，著名巧克力而闻名。  
**原子塔:** 是一个现代建筑的奇迹，为Expo'58所建造的。1958年布鲁塞尔是世博会主办国。  
**布鲁塞尔皇宫:** 名义上是比利时王室的官邸，但是国王和皇后并不住在这里。皇宫是比利时国王行使他国家元首特权、接见客人和处理国家事务的地方。  
**撒尿小童:** 这座闻名于世的小男孩铜像是一座落于市中心步行区的雕像及喷水池。这个五岁小孩身材的雕像不大，但有将近四百年历史。  
**巴黎:** 法国的首都，一个美丽而浪漫的城市。  
**巴黎 - Mercure Paris Val de Fontenay 或同级**

第8天 巴黎 早午晚

**巴黎市区游:** 荣军院、香榭丽舍大街和历史悠久的**巴黎圣母院**及**浮罗宫博物馆**。  
**艾菲尔铁塔(含登二层电梯):** 世界著名的巴黎图标和结构。  
**凯旋门:** 拿破仑率领的法国军队在奥斯特利茨战役中击败了俄奥联军，国威达到史无前例的顶峰。为了炫耀国力，并庆祝战争的胜利。  
**协和广场:** 广场上充满了雕塑和喷泉，1763年以当时的国王命名为路易十五广场。  
**老佛爷百货公司:** 一个高档的法国百货，在这里您可以找到标志性的时尚品牌商品。  
**塞纳河(含船游):** 欣赏巴黎和塞纳河边风景如画的古迹和迷人桥梁。  
**巴黎 - Mercure Paris Val de Fontenay 或同级**

**Day 1** Depart ✈️ **Transit City** MOB

Assemble at international airport, departure flight to Switzerland - Zurich via transit city.

**Day 2** Transit City ✈️ **Zurich** MOB/D

Zurich: The largest city in Switzerland, the most affluent city in Europe, also known as the "European billionaire city".

**Zurich City Tour:** Takes you past Lake Zurich, and makes photo stops at the **Fraumunster Church** with its famous Chagall windows, historical **Limmatquai** and the **City Hall**.

**Bahnhofstrasse:** The richest street in the world. Built by the Romans on the shores of lake Zurich during Roman rule in 15bc, the city began to develop into a thriving trading hub and one of the world's most expensive streets.

Zurich - A-Ja Resort Zurich or Similar

**Day 3** Zurich 55km Lucerne 55km Zurich BLD

**Mount Titlis (Include Cable Car):** A mountain of the Uri Alps, at 3,238 metres above sea level, it is the highest summit of the range north of the Susten Pass.

Lucerne: The capital of central Switzerland.

**Chapel Bridge:** The oldest bridge in Europe, one of the famous attraction in Switzerland.

**Lion Monument:** It was carved into a cliff to commemorate the Swiss Guards who lost their lives during the French Revolution.

**Lake Lucerne:** The fifth largest lake in central Switzerland.

**Bucherer Shop:** A leading jewellery and Swiss watch boutique.

Zurich: The largest city in Switzerland, the most affluent city in Europe, also known as the "European billionaire city".

Zurich - A-Ja Resort Zurich or Similar

**Day 4** Zurich 410km Frankfurt BLD

**Rhine Falls:** The largest waterfall in Europe, also a border between Switzerland and Germany.

Frankfurt: The largest city in the German state of Hesse and the fifth-largest city in Germany.

**Titisee:** The largest natural lake in the Black Forest. It originated in the Ice Age as a moraine - water of the former Feldberg - the glacier.

**Cuckoo Clock Shop:** A clock that announces the time by a cuckoo sound, often equipped with a mechanical cuckoo. The clock has become a cultural icon of Germany.

**Drubba Shop:** Picturesque complex offering high-end stores with clothes, jewelry, purses and artful cuckoo clocks.

Frankfurt - TRYP by Wyndham Frankfurt or Similar

**Day 5** Frankfurt 190km Cologne 268km Amsterdam BLD

Cologne: The fourth-largest city in Germany.

**The Cologne Cathedral:** As known as "Black Church", one of the landmark in Cologne city. It was designated as the world's cultural heritage in 1996.

**Great St. Martin Church:** A Romanesque Catholic church built on what was then an island in the Rhine. The church was later transformed into a Benedictine monastery. The current buildings, including a soaring crossing tower that is a landmark of Cologne's Old Town, **Cologne City Hall:** It is Germany's oldest city hall with a documented history spanning some 900 years.

Amsterdam: It is synonymous for windmills and canal, also known as "little Venice".

Amsterdam - The niu Fender or Similar

**Day 6** Amsterdam BLD

**Zaanse Schans:** Famous windmills for the local living use.

**Clog Factory & Cheese Factory:** You will have chance to see how the wooden clogs and Dutch cheese are made.

**Volendam:** Well-known for old fishing boats and the traditional clothing still worn by some residents.

During the tulip season (22 March - 13 May), Volendam will be replaced by Keukenhof Garden.

**Diamond Cutting Factory:** To know how the diamonds are polished into sparkling gems with professional technology.

**Amsterdam Canal (Include Cruising):** You will sit in a glass-domed boat that will take you past the Magere Brug, Science Museum, Harbor, Railway Station and other buildings.

**Dam Square:** A best-known town square in Amsterdam.

**Royal Palace:** The building started out in 1655 as Amsterdam's City Hall, but re-purposed as a palace in 1808 by the brother of Napoleon.

**National Monument:** Erected in 1956 to memorialize the victims of World War II.

**De Wallen:** Known as red light district in Amsterdam.

Brussels: The largest city and capital of Belgium, also known as famous chocolate city.

**Atomium:** A marvel of modern architecture, constructed for Expo'58, the 1958 Brussels World's fair.

**Royal Palace:** The official palace of the King and Queen of the Belgians. However, it is not used as a royal residence, as the king and his family live in the Royal Palace of Laeken in northern Brussels.

**Manneken Pis:** The famous "peeing boy" statue, more 400 years of history.

Paris: The capital of France, a beautiful and romantic city.

**Paris City Tour:** Drive along **Les Invalides**, **Champs-Elysees**, **Notre Dame (Cathedral)** and **Louvre Museum**.

**Arc de Triomphe:** It was commissioned in 1806 after the victory at Austerlitz by Emperor Napoleon at the peak of his fortunes.

**Galleries Lafayette:** An upmarket French department store where you can find iconic and latest branded goods.

**Seine River (Include Cruising):** To discover the full splendor of the river banks and monuments of Paris.
